

A definition for transient and nontransient water systems can be found at 10 VSA section 1671:

(11) "Noncommunity water system" means a public water system that is not a community water system. There are two categories of noncommunity systems:

(A) "nontransient" systems, which are systems which serve 25 or more of the same people daily for more than six months in any year; and

(B) "transient" systems, which are all other noncommunity public water systems.
